General

The Church of St. George ("Church of St. George") takes your privacy matters very seriously. This Privacy Policy ("Privacy Policy") details how Church of St. George receives, collects and uses personal information in connection with our website stgeorge.fi ("Website") and Church of St. George's services and products. Website and the Church of St. George services and products offered to you through Website and any part thereof are collectively referred to in these terms as the "Service".

Purpose of Processing Personal Information

The purpose of Church of St. George's processing of personal information is to:

- (i) provide the Service to the user;
- (ii) ensure an efficient and secure use of the Service;
- (iii) provide customized Service and other content recognizing user specific needs and interests:
- (iv) improve, develop and analyze our Service and other Church of St. George's business activities;

- (v) manage customer relations, as well as to provide good customer service; and
- (vi) conduct research and collect statistics;

The Personal Information may also be used for direct marketing purposes, market research and to fulfil the requirements based on legislation and authority regulations.

Church of St. George will store personal information only for as long as is necessary in order to fulfil the purposes set out in this section and/or in accordance with the applicable legislation.

Data Subjects

Church of St. George collects personal information on persons who use the Service or if the collection of personal information derives from a legal obligation. Most of the personal information is collected from the data subjects themselves when the user creates a user account and/or uses the Service. Updates to the personal information may also be received from authorities, organizations, companies offering updating services, public directories and other public sources of information.

When visiting the Website or using the Service, certain technical and other information (that may be personal information) may be automatically sent by your computer to Church of St. George (e.g. IP address, the type of your browser and the source of your visit). Church of St. George can also collect information about your website usage information by using cookies. Please see the Cookies section of this Privacy Policy for further information. Any or all of the activities with regard to Website usage information may be performed on our behalf by our service providers, including, for example, our analytics vendor(s) and our e-mail management partner(s).

In the event Church of St. George makes message boards and forums available to users (collectively, "Forums"), users will be solely responsible for the information and any other content you post on and through these Forums and should be aware that when you voluntarily disclose personal information (e.g. name, e-mail address, telephone number) on or through these Forums, such information is generally accessible to, and may be collected and used by, other users. This may result in unsolicited messages from third parties, and such messages are beyond our control. Robbo does not exercise control over any users or Website visitors, and in no way is Church of St. George responsible, nor does Church of St. George have any liability whatsoever, for any collection or use of information you may disclose through the Forums. This Privacy Policy does not cover such disclosure of information. You are encouraged to exercise discretion when providing personal information about yourself in and through Forums. Please do not post any personal information on the Website that you expect to keep private.

Information Church of St. George Collects

Church of St. George may collect the following Information from you when you create a user account and/or use the Service. By voluntarily providing us with personal information, you are consenting to our use of it in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

- o Personal Information (first name, last name, email address, telephone number)
- o Company Information (email address, telephone number, visiting-, or mailing address)

The information is collected when you contact us (online or offline) in connection with a request for information, to order a product or service, to provide you with support, we collect information necessary to fulfill your request, to grant you access to the product or service, to provide you with support and to be able to contact you.

Usage and other Non-Identifiable Data:

When you use the Website and/or Service, Church of St. George receives and stores certain personally non-identifiable information, such as the total number of visitors to our Website, the number of visitors to each page of our Website, device and browser information as well as Service usage data. We cannot currently use this information to identify you. It is important to note that no personal information is available or used in this process.

Aggregated Personal Information and other Information:

In an ongoing effort to better understand and serve our users, Church of St. George conducts research on user demographics, interests and behaviour based on the personal information and other information provided to us. Church of St. George compiles and analyses this research on an aggregate basis, and may share this aggregate data with partners of Church of St. George. This aggregate information does not identify you personally. Church of St. George may also disclose aggregated user statistics in order to describe our services to current and prospective business partners, and to other third parties for other lawful purposes.

Church of St. George also collects information regarding the use of Service in order to better understand user behaviour and trends, detect potential outages and technical issues. All log analysis is done in an anonymous, aggregate, non-personally identifiable manner.

Regular Destinations of Disclosed Data and The Transfer of Personal Information To Countries Outside of The European Union or The European Economic Area

Church of St. George may disclose the personal information within the limits of the applicable legislation. Personal information may be disclosed to co-operation partners chosen by Church of St. George for their marketing purposes, unless the data subject prohibits such disclosure of his/her data. The recipients of such personal information are not allowed to disclose the personal information further.

The confidentiality of the personal information may be broken when required by law or statute, or by ruling of authority.

Due to the technical and practical requirements, some of the personal information may be processed by subcontractors located outside the European Union or European Economic Area or at the subcontractors' servers outside the European Union or European Economic Area. If any personal information is transferred outside the EU or EEA, Church of St. George will ensure that the country to which the personal information is transferred is approved as having a sufficient level of privacy protection by the European Commission, or by using standard contractual model clauses approved by the European Commission.

The Principles of Securing the Data Register

Church of St. George uses technical and organizational measures to protect personal information against unauthorized access, transfer, deletion or other handling that may compromise information security. Such methods include the use of firewalls, encryption technologies and safe server rooms, proper access control systems, the controlled provision of user rights and supervision of their use, providing instructions for data processors, and the thorough selection of competent subcontractors who comply with industry standards for information security management.

Only appointed personnel of Church of St. George and of companies operating by Church of St. George's assignment or on behalf of Church of St. George are entitled to use personal information. All persons processing the personal information have a personal right of use granted by Church of St. George.

Right of Access, Correction and Prohibition

You may at any time contact Church of St. George to check that the personal information related to you is accurate. Upon your request, Church of St. George will modify, remove or supplement any incorrect, unnecessary, incomplete or outdated personal information.

The request to must be made in writing to Church of St. George and it must be signed. The request for right of access can also be presented in person in the main office of Church of St. George at the address PL 384, 00880 HELSINKI, Finland.

The user has the right to prohibit Church of St. George from processing his/her personal information for purposes of direct advertising, distance selling, other direct marketing and market research and opinion polls.

If you no longer wish to receive e-mail communication from Church of St. George, such as offers, updates and newsletters, you may opt-out of receiving such communications by following the instructions included in each newsletter or communication.

Cookies, Clear Gifs and Other Automatically Collected Data

If you have permitted your computer to accept cookies, Church of St. George may use cookies on the Website. Cookies are pieces of information that a website transfers to an individual's hard drive for record-keeping purposes. Cookies make web-surfing easier by saving preferences and browsing patterns while you are at the Website. Cookies may be used to analyze the Website usage, improve content, customize the Website's content and layout and for other customer service purposes. A cookie may enable us to relate your use of our Website to other information about you, including your Personal Information. All of these purposes serve to improve and personalize your experience on our Website. Most Web browsers can be set to inform you when a cookie has been sent to you and provide you with the opportunity to refuse that cookie. Additionally, if you have a Flash player installed on your computer, your Flash player can be set to reject or delete Flash cookies. However, refusing a cookie may, in some cases, preclude you from using, or negatively impact the display or function of, the Website or certain areas or features of the Website.

Church of St. George may use "clear GIFs" (aka "Web beacons" or "pixel tags") or similar technologies, in the Website and/or in our communications with you to enable us to evaluate Website usage information about visitors to the Website, target campaigns, upgrade visitor information, and know whether you have visited a Website or received a message. A clear GIF is typically a one-pixel, transparent image (although it can be a visible image as well), located on a web page or in an e-mail or other type of message, which is retrieved from a remote site on the Internet enabling the verification of an individual's viewing or receipt of a web page or message. A clear gif may enable us to relate your viewing or receipt of a web page or message to other information about you, including your personal information.

Third-Party Sites and Privacy Practices

Website may contain links that will let you leave Website and access another website. Websites linked to or from Website are not under the control of Church of St. George and it is possible that these websites have a different privacy policy. This Privacy Policy applies solely to personal information that is acquired on the Website or through your use of the Service, and/or your relationship with Church of St. George urges you to be careful when you enter any personal information online. Church of St. George accepts no responsibility or liability for these other websites.

Analytics Collection

Church of St. George may use website analytics, such as Adobe Analytics and Google Analytics to gather anonymous statistics about the users of the Website with the aim to improve the Website. If Church of St. George uses such analytics, it will provide the user an opt-out function to indicate that you do not want Church of St. George to track your visits to Website.

Children's Privacy

The Website and Service are not intended for or designed to attract anyone under the age of 13 and we do not intentionally or knowingly collect personal information on our sites from anyone under the age of 13 (or older in some jurisdictions). We encourage parents to be involved in the online activities of their children to ensure that no information is collected from a child without parental permission.

Changes to Policy

From time to time, Church of St. George may revise this Privacy Policy. Church of St. George reserves the right to update or modify this Privacy Policy, or any other of our policies or practices, at any time with or without notice. However, we will not use your personal information in a way that is materially different than the uses described in this Privacy Policy without giving you an opportunity to opt-out of such differing uses.

Church of St. George will post the revised Privacy Policy on the Website, so that users can always be aware of what information we collect, how the information is used and under what circumstances such information may be disclosed. You agree to review the Privacy Policy periodically so that you are aware of any modifications. Your continued use of the Website and/or Service indicates your assent to any changes and signifies your agreement to the terms of our Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with these terms, you should not use the Website or the Service.

Governing Law

This Privacy Policy shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of Finland, excluding its conflicts of law rules, and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Finland.
